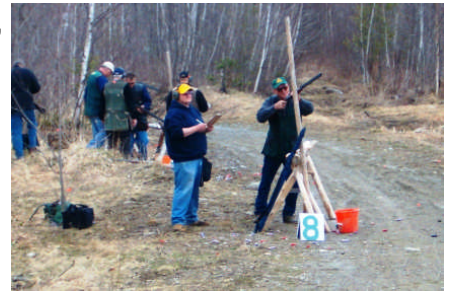
AUGUST 18 & 19TH: SPORTING CLAYS SHOOT
