Long Bird

Entry Fee of \$5/10 targets

Shooters will start at 50 yards and have 10
chances to break the target (same trap).

The shooter breaking the most out of 10
wins. We will continue to back up 10 yards
at a time.

Turkey Still Target Competition

Entry Fee of \$10/3tries. NWTF rules apply.

Distance: 40 yards

Shooting Position: Sitting

Barrel length: not to exceed 32"

Ammo: Factory loads: 12ga 3" and 20 ga 3"

Shot size: #4, #5, #6

Classes: 12ga Open, 20 ga Open, Ladies
20ga, Jakes 20ga

Optics: Scopes are allowed

Sights: All styles

Target: Most shot in 3" circle

5 Stand

Entry Fee of \$10/25 targets

There will be 5 stations in a line with 6-8
traps. Menus will be set for each station.

There will be tower, rabbit, crossing and
incoming shots. A good warmup for the
Main event.

Directions: From 95N take exit 133 to Rt 201 N, Turn right over the bridge in Hinckley onto Rt23N. About 6 miles look for Tuttle Rd which bears right. At the end of Tuttle Rd turn right onto Hill Rd.
